#### COMPETITION WATERS:

- **Lake D'Arbonne** - Qualifying Rounds, Feb. 5-8
- **Caney Creek Reservoir** - Knockout Round, Feb. 9
- **Bussey Brake** - Championship Round, Feb. 10

#### OFFICIAL RAMPS / STAGING AREAS:

- Lake D'Arbonne State Park, 3628 Evergreen Road, Farmerville, LA 71241, (GPS: 32°46'29.6"N, 92°28'41.2"W)
- Caney Creek Hook's Marina, 400 Spillway Road, Chatham, LA 71226, (GPS: 32°13'34.8"N, 92°29'18.4"W)
- Bussey Brake Bonner Ferry Rd, 5mi NW of Bastrop, off of Hwy 593, (GPS: 32°52'16.2"N, 91°54'40.7"W)

#### SCORABLE BASS:

- **Lake D'Arbonne:** Approved species of bass must weigh **1 pound, 8 ounces** or more to be scorable and every scorable bass counts.
- **Caney Creek Reservoir:** Approved species of bass must weigh **2 pounds** or more to be scorable and every scorable bass counts.
- **Bussey Brake:** Approved species of bass must weigh **2 pounds** or more to be scorable and every scorable bass counts.

#### OFF-LIMITS:

- 12:01 a.m. on Jan. 4 until 30 minutes prior to official sunrise on Feb. 3.

#### ALL ANGLER MEETING:

- **Feb. 2 at 5:30 p.m.** - Location TBA.
- This in-person meeting is mandatory for all MLF Bass Pro Tour anglers. Anglers must wear a collared polo-style shirt or jersey.

#### OFFICIAL PRACTICE HOURS:

- **Feb. 3 - D'Arbonne and/or Caney Creek:** 30 minutes prior to official sunrise to 30 minutes after official sunset.
- **Feb. 4 - D'Arbonne and/or Caney Creek:** 30 minutes prior to official sunrise until 6 p.m.
- **Feb. 7 - Group B - Bussey Brake:** 4-hour ride through only.
- **Feb. 8 - Group A - Bussey Brake:** 4-hour ride through only.

#### COMPETITION SCHEDULE & FORMAT:

- **Feb. 5** - Qualifying Group A, Day 1 - 40 anglers - Carry weight to Qualifying Group A, Day 2
- **Feb. 6** - Qualifying Group B, Day 1 - 40 anglers - Carry weight to Qualifying Group B, Day 2
- **Feb. 7** - Qualifying Group A, Day 2 - 40 anglers - Total two-day weight - Top 20 advance - Winner advances to Championship Round
- **Feb. 8** - Qualifying Group B, Day 2 - 40 anglers - Total two-day weight - Top 20 advance - Winner advances to Championship Round
- **Feb. 9** - Knockout Round - 38 Anglers - Zeroed weight - One-day total weight - Eight advance
- **Feb. 10** - Championship Round - 10 anglers - Zeroed weight - One-day total weight

#### COMPETITION HOURS (Central Time Zone):

- **Period 1** - 9-11:30 a.m.
- **Period 2** - 11:45 a.m. to 2:15 p.m.
- **Period 3** - 2:30-5 p.m. (End of competition)

#### PRE-COMPETITION STAGING:

- Each morning before the competition begins, competing MLF anglers will pick up their MLF official, MLF STAT unit, and MLF camera operator at an official staging area prior to takeoff. MLF anglers will depart from the daily pre-staging location to the ramp in a controlled, orderly fashion for takeoff. Takeoff will begin approximately 30 minutes prior to official lines in.

#### TAKEOFF PROCEEDURE:

- Takeoff order will be randomized before the first day of competition. When all boats have been put into the water and MLF anglers are ready, a fast-paced but safe takeoff will begin in order from 1-40 on Day 1 and reversed 40-1 on each group's second competition day. Knockout Round anglers will depart in the order of their Qualifying Round finish. Championship Round anglers will depart in the order of their Knockout Round finish. The estimated takeoff time will be approximately 30 minutes prior to official lines in. Anglers will have their names announced, with a 5-second interval between each name.

**TOURNAMENT PAYOUTS:**

- Payouts for this tournament will total \$806,640. The following reflects the payouts by place finish and Big Bass:

**QUALIFICATION FOR MLF ANGLER OF THE YEAR:**

- The MLF Bass Pro Tour angler with the highest accumulated year-end points following all seven Bass Pro Tour events will be recognized as the “MLF Bass Pro Tour Angler of the Year”

**QUALIFICATION FOR MLF REDCREST:**

- During each of the 2022 Bass Pro Tour events, MLF anglers will earn qualifying points towards 2023 MLF REDCREST. Qualifying points will be awarded according to individual place finish at the end of each Bass Pro Tour event; Top 39 anglers in year-end points after all Bass Pro Tour events have been completed will advance to 2023 MLF REDCREST. Points are reset to zero at the beginning of each year.

**QUALIFICATION FOR MLF GENERAL TIRE HEAVY HITTERS:**

- During each of the 2022 Bass Pro Tour events, MLF anglers have the opportunity to qualify for the 2023 MLF GENERAL TIRE HEAVY HITTERS event, based on the total weight of the angler’s biggest bass caught at each of the 2022 Bass Pro Tour events (one bass per event for a total of seven).

**TOURNAMENT POINTS:**

- Points for this tournament will be awarded according to each angler’s tournament place finish.
