- No practice is permitted at night. Pros may only be on the water from 30 minutes before sunrise through 30 minutes after sunset June 1-2. Pros must be off the water by 2 p.m. June 3.

Boat Numbers & Takeoff Order:

- **Qualifying Round:** Boat numbers will be randomly assigned within Groups A and B. Takeoff order will be boats 1-40 on each group's first day of qualifying and 40-1 on each group's second day of qualifying.
- **Knockout Round:** Anglers will take off in order of their Qualifying Round finish. The highest finishers from each group will take off simultaneously as the number 1 boats.
- **Championship Round:** Anglers will take off in order of their Knockout Round finish.
