 - Eastern Boundary – Moses Saunders Power Dam
 - Western Tibbetts Point – N 44 06.032 W 76 22.247
 - Kingston Marina Wall – N 44 13.460 W 76 28.716
 - South Side Wolf Island – N 44 07.618 W 76 22.894
 - North Side – N 44 11.378 W 76 27.96
- No locking through the Eisenhower Lock at Massena, NY
- Lake Ontario is off limits.

License Requirement:

- A [New York fishing license](#) is required. Canada waters require a Canada license.

Off-limits:

- July 4-Aug. 2, 2024

Practice:

- Aug. 3-5, 2024
- No practice is permitted at night. Pros may only be on the water from 30 minutes before sunrise through 30 minutes after sunset Aug. 3-4. Pros must be off the water by 2 p.m. Aug. 5.

Boat Numbers & Takeoff Order:

- **Qualifying Round:** Boat numbers will be randomly assigned within Groups A and B. Takeoff order will be boats 1-40 on each group's first day of qualifying and 40-1 on each group's second day of qualifying.
- **Knockout Round:** Anglers will take off in order of their Qualifying Round finish. The highest finishers from each group will take off simultaneously as the number 1 boats.
- **Championship Round:** Anglers will take off in order of their Knockout Round finish.
